

## **Presidential Cabinet of Chile 1970-1973 Positions List:**

Humberto Martones - Ministry of National Assets: As Minister of National Assets, Martones deals with territorial matters, including the possible overtake of territory by the government itself, the private industry and foreign investors.

Sergio Bitar Chacra - Ministry of Mining: As the Minister of Mining, Chacra is tasked with developing public policies on mining that boost national development while maintaining the desires both of mining companies as well as, and most importantly, the government.

Jacques Chonchol - Ministry of Agriculture: As Minister of Agriculture, Chonchol's task lies in reducing social inequality within the agricultural industry, supporting small-scale and family farming, growing the industry by means such as the development of instruments, as well as adding value to agriculture.

Humberto Magliochetti Barahona - Ministry of Public Works: As Minister of Public Works Barahona is in charge of planning, studying, designing and constructing as well as repairing, maintaining and operating public infrastructure in Chile.

José Oyarce - Ministry of Labor and Social Forecast: As the Minister of Labor and Social Forecast, Oyarce represents the interest of the Chilean workforce, both public and private. This includes job training, health & safety matters, and other government regulations that pertain to labor.

Sergio Insunza Barrios - Ministry of Justice and Human Rights: As the Minister of Justice and Human rights, Barrios is responsible for maintaining and modernizing the nation's justice system. This includes public defense of criminals, protection of minors, the prison system, and human rights.

Aníbal Palma - Ministry of Education: As the Minister of Education, Palma is responsible for the development of Chile's public education system. This includes advocating for scientific research, artistic creativity, and the preservation of the nation's culture and history in schools.

Jaime Suarez Bastidas - Ministry General Secretariat of Government: As the Minister General Secretariat of Government, Bastidas is responsible for providing advice to the President with regards to government communications.

Orlando Millas - Ministry of Finance: As the Minister of Finance, Millas is responsible for various aspects of the Chilean economy. This includes fiscal policy, which has to do with the collection of taxes and government spending of tax revenues.

Jose Toha Gonzalez - Ministry of National Defense: As the Minister of National Defense, Gonzalez is responsible for “maintaining the independence and sovereignty” of Chile, which essentially means protecting it from external threats.

Clodomiro Almeyda Medina - Ministry of Foreign Affairs: As the Minister of Foreign Affairs, it is Medina’s duty to contribute to the design of foreign policy, as defined by the President of Chile, and to carry out and coordinate its implementation in the context of a foreign policy system, in which State, civil society and other private and public actors interact.

Carlos Prats Gonzalez - Ministry of the Interior and Public Security: As Interior Minister, it is Gonzalez’s duty to propose regulations and initiatives related to internal policies that are designed to maintain public order and safeguard the security and social peace in Chile.
